

# Cornhole Tournament Rules

**The Boards** – The boards measure 2 ft. in width 4 ft. in length. The hole is 6" diameter and measures 9" from the top of the board to the center of the hole.

**The Bags** – The bags being used are 6" x 6" in size and weigh 16 oz.

**Spacing** – Each board will be positioned at a distance of 27' from the front of one to the other.

## **Tournament Format**

This will be a single elimination tournament. The number of teams will be determined by the number of entries but to be limited to no more than 64 teams. Team placement is randomly determined prior to the start of the tournament.

## **Scoring**

START: The team listed at the top of the bracket will use the "DARKER" of the sets of bags and will throw first to begin every tournament game. Players will alternate throws until all 8 bags have been thrown.

Scoring:

- a. Each bag on the box = 1 point. Each bag in the hole = 3 points
- b. Any bags touching the ground or "bounced" on to the box do not count and are to be removed prior to the next bag being thrown by the opposing team.
- c. Total points for each team are calculated. The team scoring the most points in a round receives their total score.
- d. The team who last scores will have the first throw of the round.
- e. The first team to achieve a score of 21 points will be declared the winner.

## **Ground Rules**

- a. The winning team is to collect and return ALL bags and report their final score to the tournament director at the registration table.
- b. There are no cancellations, "skunk" or early elimination scores.
- c. The tournament committee will have the final decision regarding any questions or conflicts arising throughout the tournament
